

Task 1: (Science)

'Diversity' (not the Dance group!) is the theme of Science Week in March - think about this word means to you and create some art to represent your understanding of it.



Task 2: (Designing and Making)

Create a 3D piece of art (Mask, model or artefact, sculpture) to go with your Greek Myth e.g. A mask of a character, a model of an item from the myth or a building represented in a Myth.

Task 3 (Poetry)

Choose your favourite poem or one that you enjoy, learn it and practise it to perform to the class. Think about the actions you could include and props that could make your performance even better. You could video yourself and email it to the class email address too.

During the rest of the Spring Term, we would like to give you the flexibility to choose which Home Learning task suits your home timetable.
